


WINSLOW RECYCLES!

Thank-you for using the "DROP OFF" recycling trailers located at the Winslow Library!

Please deliver only clean, acceptable materials.



We now recycle almost 3 tons of residential waste per week at our low cost facility.

We thank-you for your cooperation.

TIN CANS ARE NOT ACCEPTED HERE – place these in your regular garbage. Tin cans are removed from the garbage mechanically at our *Energy Recycling Facility* using a magnetic separator. We receive credit for our proportional share of recycled tin.

TRAILERS ARE PROCESSED THREE TIMES A WEEK – 3 mornings a week, when full. Please feel free to leave your materials on the platform if one trailer is temporarily unavailable.

DROP OFF ONLY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FOR RECYCLING

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, PERIODICALS - place in bin labeled "NEWSPAPER"

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD & BROWN PAPER BAGS - Flatten and place in bin labeled "CARDBOARD"

#2 PLASTIC MILK & LAUNDRY JUGS, CLEAR & COLORED - Rinse and Crush!

PAPER BOARD, EGG CARTONS, CEREAL & CRACKER BOXES -without plastic liners, PIZZA BOXES not soiled
NO junk mail and NO paper milk jugs

EACH TON RECYCLED SAVES \$10 COMPARED TO ENERGY RECOVERY!

SMALL RESIDENTIAL LOADS OF LIMBS AND BRUSH (no other wood materials and no construction debris) – you may arrange with the Public Works Department to deposit your brush (4" DIAMETER OR LESS) at our yard. We will need to inspect the load and we are only available during regular business hours.

BULKY WASTE – Contact a private hauler or *Capitol City Transfer* (873-1219 ext 3)

WINSLOW RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION & RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Residential Garbage:

- 1) Normal kitchen waste will be collected. Yard waste, bulky waste, remodeling waste and hazardous materials will NOT be collected as these are not included in our disposal contract with *Penobscot Energy Recovery Corporation*. *Capital City Transfer* accepts many of these items and they are located at the end of the Airport Road in Waterville (telephone 873-1219 ext 3).
- 2) Place rubbish within 6 feet of the curb or edge of pavement before 7 a.m.
- 3) Trash cans should have two handles and not exceed a capacity of 39 gallons. Trash bags may be placed instead of cans, but neither individual bags nor a full can should exceed 50 pounds. Rubbish in boxes or paper bags will NOT be collected as these frequently bust and may litter the surrounding area.
- 4) If a town employee drops garbage, we will clean it up. If litter is present when we arrive (as a result of birds, cats and dogs opening bags), we will not clean it up.
- 5) Please, do NOT place oil-based paints, pool chemicals, ashes, pesticides and the like in your garbage. These pose serious dangers to employees. Call us with any questions.
- 6) Sharp items such as hypodermic needles should be disposed of in a sharps container, or into empty rigid plastic jugs such as liquid laundry soap containers (tightly shut).

Recycling Drop Off – located at the Winslow Public Library:

- 1) Please deposit “clean” recyclable materials using our *RECYCLING DROP OFF FACILITY*
- 2) Our trailers accept corrugated cardboard, #2 plastic, newspapers, magazines, paper board (not including wet strength such as milk or ice cream containers) and office paper.
- 3) Instructional sign is posted on the ramp. See other side for details.
- 4) Tin cans are extracted from your regular garbage at *Penobscot Energy Recovery Program*.

Yard Waste Drop Off – located at the Public Works Garage:

- 1) For Winslow Residents only, not for use by contractors.
- 2) Available Monday through Thursday 7 a.m.-3 p.m. (April – November)
- 3) Load must be inspected by a Public Works employee prior to dumping on site
- 4) Only three types of material are accepted
 - a) Brush less than 4” diameter, maximum of 12 feet long
 - b) Clean grass clippings
 - c) Clean leaves
- 5) Grass or leaves mixed with litter will not be accepted
- 6) We are chipping brush, therefore we retain the right to refuse loads if volume exceeds available labor hours.
