



Fort Halifax Park is located on a peninsula at the confluence of the Kennebec and Sebasticook Rivers in Winslow, Maine. The park can be accessed from Bay Street and consists of rolling open grassy areas dotted with shade trees and picnic areas, as well as outstanding views up and down the rivers. The most dominant feature in the park is a timber blockhouse, the only remaining structure of what was once Fort Halifax. The Fort Halifax site is a National Historic Landmark and is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places. The other dominant feature in the park is a permanent band stand, which is used to provide outdoor concerts and entertainment.
