Other News of Note

We will be joining the MILS library system the first week in October. By joining the statewide library network we will make over nine million titles in libraries around the state easily available to our patrons with online interlibrary loan through our library catalog. Our patrons will be able to request titles from other libraries on their own, from any computer with an Internet connection, to be delivered here to Winslow Public Library. We will switching to this new library automation system on October 5th.

Winslow Public Library was honored to be one of the two Maine public libraries visited by representatives of the Federal Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) while they were conducting their regular 5 year audit of the Maine State Library in August. A thank you message from the program officer who visited us stated, in part, "It is always helpful for us to see libraries in person that have benefitted from federal funds, and we commend Winslow Public Library for taking advantage of so many state-level programs." Some of these Programs are: the MARVEL databases, Learning Express, the Download Library, the Voluntary Public Library Staff Certification Program, and our coming membership in the MILS statewide library catalog and automation system.
